## MATERIALS

Hooded Scarf					
F095 Funky Fur shade 565	3	3	3	4	50g balls
Plain Scarf					
F095 Funky Fur shade 564	2	2	2	2	50g balls
Twirly Scarf					
F095 Funky Fur shade 561	2	2	2	2	50g balls
Snood					
F095 Funky Fur shade 563			1	2	50g balls

The yarn amounts are based on average requirements when specified tension and yarn is used. You will also need 1 Pair of 5½mm (UK5 - USA9) Knitting Needles.

## TENSION

18 sts and 22 rows to 10cm, (4in) over stocking stitch on 5½mm needles or the size required to give correct tension.

Check your tension - if less stitches use a thinner needle, if more use a thicker needle.

**IT IS ESSENTIAL TO WORK TO THE STATED TENSION TO ENSURE SUCCESS.**

## ABBREVIATIONS

**cm** centimetres, **cont** continue, **fol** following, **g** grammes, **in** inch(es), **inc** increase(ing), **k** knit, **mm** millimetres, **patt** pattern, **p** purl, **rs** right side, **st(s)** stitch(es), **ws** wrong side.

**Wrap 1** slip next stitch onto right hand needle and take yarn to opposite side of the work between needles, slip the same stitch back onto the left hand needle.

### Circle the size you wish to make

Cast off.

### HOODED SCARF SCARF

Using thumb method cast on 28 [28:28:32] sts.

**1st Row.** Knit.

**2nd Row.** Purl.

These 2 rows will now be referred to as **st-st** (stocking stitch).

Working in st-st (throughout) cont until scarf measures 80 [90:100:120]cm, (31½ [35½:

39½:47¼]in), ending with a ws row.

Cast off.

With rs facing, fold scarf in half lengthways, place a marker at centre of scarf, then a marker 21 [22:23:25]cm, (8¼ [8¾:9:9¾]in), from each side of centre marker.

### HOOD

#### Right side of Hood

With rs facing, starting at marker on right side pick up and knit 37 [39:41:45] sts evenly along right side edge of scarf from marker to centre marker.

\*\* Starting with a purl row work 5 rows in st-st, Work 31 rows inc 1 st at centre edge in next and every foll 6th [6th:6th:10th] row. 43 [45:47:49] sts.

Cont without shaping until right side of hood measures 21 [22:24:28]cm, (8¼ [8¾:9½:11]in), ending with a ws row.

#### Left side of Hood

With rs facing, starting at centre marker pick up and knit 37 [39:41:45] sts from centre marker to marker at left side of scarf.

Work as given for Right side of Hood from \*\*.

### TO MAKE UP

Join back and top seams of hood. See ball band for washing and care instructions.

### PLAIN SCARF

Using thumb method cast on 25 sts.

**1st Row.** Knit.

**2nd Row.** Purl.

These 2 rows will now be referred to as **st-st** (stocking stitch).

Working in st-st (throughout) cont until 2 balls of yarn have been used, ending with a ws row, leaving enough yarn to cast off.

Cast off.

### TO COMPLETE

See ball band for washing and care instructions.

### TWIRLY SCARF

Using thumb method cast on 20 sts.

**1st Row.** K13, p1, k6.

**2nd Row.** K7, p13.

**3rd Row.** K4, wrap 1, turn.

**4th Row.** P4.

**5th Row.** K8, wrap 1, turn.

**6th Row.** P8.

**7th Row.** K12, wrap 1, turn.

**8th Row.** P12.

From 1st to 8th row sets patt.

Working in patt cont until you have used 2 balls of yarn, ending with 1st row of patt, leaving enough yarn to cast off.

Cast off in patt.

### TO COMPLETE

See ball band for washing and care instructions.

### SNOOD

Using thumb method cast on 90 [108] sts.

**1st Row.** Knit.

**2nd Row.** Purl.

These 2 rows will now be referred to as **st-st** (stocking stitch).

Working in st-st (throughout) cont until snood measures 15 [20]cm, (6 [8]in), ending with a ws row. Cast off.

### TO COMPLETE

Fold the snood in half then join side edge. See ball band for washing and care instructions.
