The yarn amounts are based on average requirements when specified tension and yarn is used. You will also need 1 Pair of 51/2mm (UK5 – USA9) Knitting Needles.

18 sts and 22 rows to 10cm, (4in) over stocking stitch on 51/2mm needles or the size required to give correct tension.

Check your tension - if less stitches use a thinner needle, if more use a thicker needle.

IT IS ESSENTIAL TO WORK TO THE STATED TENSION TO ENSURE SUCCESS.

ABBREVIATIONS

cm centimetres, cont continue, foll following, g grammes, in inch(es), inc increase(ing), k knit, mm millimetres, patt pattern, p purl, rs right side, st(s) stitch(es), ws wrong side.

Wrap 1 slip next stitch onto right hand needle and take yarn to opposite side of the work between needles, slip the same stitch back onto the left

Circle the size you wish to make

HOODED SCARF

SCARF

Using thumb method cast on 28 [28:28:32] sts.

1st Row. Knit.

2nd Row. Purl.

These 2 rows will now be referred to as st-st (stocking stitch).

Working in st-st (throughout) cont until scarf measures 80 [90:100:120]cm, (311/2 [351/2: 391/2:471/4]in), ending with a ws row. Cast off

With rs facing, fold scarf in half lengthways, place a marker at centre of scarf, then a marker 21 [22: 23:25]cm, (81/4 [83/4:9:93/4]in), from each side of centre marker.

HOOD

Right side of Hood

With rs facing, starting at marker on right side pick up and knit 37 [39:41:45] sts evenly along right side edge of scarf from marker to centre marker.

** Starting with a purl row work 5 rows in st-st, Work 31 rows inc 1 st at centre edge in next and every foll 6th [6th:6th:10th] row. 43 [45:47:49] sts. Cont without shaping until right side of hood measures 21 [22:24:28]cm, (81/4 [83/4:91/2:11]in), ending with a ws row.

Cast off.

Left side of Hood

With rs facing, starting at centre marker pick up and knit 37 [39:41:45] sts from centre marker to marker at left side of scarf.

Work as given for Right side of Hood from **.

TO MAKE UP

Join back and top seams of hood. See ball band for washing and care instructions.

PLAIN SCARE

Using thumb method cast on 25 sts.

1st Row. Knit.

2nd Row. Purl.

These 2 rows will now be referred to as st-st (stocking stitch).

Working in st-st (throughout) cont until 2 balls of yarn have been used, ending with a ws row, leaving enough yarn to cast off.

TO COMPLETE

See ball band for washing and care instructions.

Using thumb method cast on 20 sts.

1st Row. K13, p1, k6.

Cast off. TO COMPLETE

2nd Row. K7, p13. 3rd Row. K4, wrap 1, turn.

5th Row. K8, wrap 1, turn.

7th Row. K12, wrap 1, turn.

From 1st to 8th row sets patt.

Working in patt cont until you have used 2 balls of

varn, ending with 1st row of patt, leaving enough

See ball band for washing and care instructions.

Using thumb method cast on 90 [108] sts.

These 2 rows will now be referred to as st-st

Working in st-st (throughout) cont until snood

4th Row. P4

6th Row. P8.

8th Row. P12.

varn to cast off.

Cast off in patt.

TO COMPLETE

1st Row. Knit.

(stocking stitch).

SNOOD

Fold the snood in half then join side edge. See ball band for washing and care instructions.
