Our vibrant and cheeky set will live up your cold winter days! Realized in Echos, very warm and sustainable and a colorful touch in Mistral Baby. A pleasant and comfortable cuddle to be tried in this amazing combination of shades!



Yarn: ECHOS col. 2377, MISTRAL BABY col. 1104, MISTRAL col. 163.

Hat is 44 cm (17,32 in.) in circumference and 26 cm (10,23 in.) in height.

Neck Warmer is 52 cm (20,47 in.) in circumference and 25 cm (9,84 in.) in height.

Echos Yarn is always worked together with Mistral Baby or Mistral Yarn.

Yarn Used: 5 balls of Echos, 1 ball Mistral Baby, 1 ball Mistral. Circular Needles: n. 8 Hat's Weight: 120 g/4,23 oz. Neck Warmer's weight: 150 g/5,29 oz. One size. Stitches Used: Mistake Rib in Round, 1x1 Rib in Round.

## Explanation Mistake Rib in round:

1<sup>st</sup> round: \*knit 2, purl 1, knit 1\*, repeat from \*to\*.
2<sup>nd</sup> round: \*purl 3, knit 1\*, repeat from \*to\*.
3<sup>rd</sup> round: repeat from 1<sup>st</sup> round.

Gauge: 10 cm x 10 cm (4 in. X 4 in.): 11 stitches and 18 rounds.

#### **Execution of neck warmer**

Using a circular needle n. 8, Echos col. 2377 and Mistral col. 163, cast on 68 stitches and work 6 round in **1x1 Rib in round**.

Continue in **Mistake Rib in round**, using Echos col. 2377 together with Mistral baby col. 1104, until 22 cm (8,66 in.) of total height.

Now, using Echos col. 2377 together with Mistral col. 163, work 5 rounds in **1x1 Rib in Round**, then bind off.

### **Execution of hat**

Using a circular needle n. 8, Echos col. 2377 and Mistral col. 163, cast on 60 stitches and work 12 rounds in **1x1 Rib in Round**.

Continue in **Mistake Rib in Round**, using Echos col. 2377 together with Mistral Baby col. 1104, until 20 cm (7,87 in.) of total height.

Now, using Echos col. 2377 together with Mistral col. 163, work 12 rounds in **1x1 Rib in Round**, then bind off.

### **FINISHING**

Neck Warmer is already finished. For the hat, bind off all stitches at the top to form the tip.
