
STOCCOLMA



A striped pattern, bright colors and a precious yarn. These are the ingredients to obtain this trendy winter sweater, with wide sleeves for an 80s volume.



Yarn: VIVIENNE col. 3645 turquoise, col. 349 beige, col. 1820 green.

Needle: n. 3,5 and 4

Weight: 285 g/ 10,05 oz. (4 balls col. turquoise, 5 balls col. beige, 3 balls col. green).


Tg. 42 - S

Stitches Used: Stockinette Stitch, Garter Stitch 1x1 Rib Tubular

*THE YARN VIVIENNE IS WORKED DOUBLE.

Gauge: 10 cm x 10 cm (4 in. x 4 in.): 22 stitches e 30 rows.

Size S: For each bigger or smaller size calculate in width 2 cm (0.75 inc.) more or less, in our gauge it corresponds to 4 stitches; calculate in height 2 cm (0.75 inc.) more or less, in our gauge it corresponds to 6 rows.





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Knitting the back: Using needle n. 3,5 and contrasting color yarn, cast on 110 stitches and knit one row (at the end of work this row will be undone); with VIVIENNE col. beige purl 1 row and work in Tubular for 4 rows, then continue in 1x1 Rib for 9 cm (3,54 in.). Continue with needles n. 4 and work in Stockinette Stitch with col. green for 4 rows, then in Garter Stitch with col. turquoise for 2 rows, in Stockinette Stitch with col. beige for 4 rows, and in Garter Stitch with col. turquoise for 2 rows. Continue with this alternating color stripe work. At a total height of 31 cm (12,20 in.), for the armhole, bind off at sides 3 stitches and continue decreasing 1 stitch every row three times, inside the first 2 stitch. At a total height of 54 cm (21,26 in.), leave suspended the 50 central stitches for the back neckline. Bind off the 24 remaining stitches on each side twice, i. e. 12 at a time.

Knitting the front: Work as done for the back. At a total height of 50 cm (19,68 in.), for the neckline, bind off the 30 central stitches and continue decreasing at sides 2 stitches every 2 rows 5 times. At a total height of 54 cm (21,26 in.), for the shoulders, bind off the 24 remaining stitches on each side twice, i.e. 12 at a time.

Sleeves: Using needle n. 3,5 and contrasting color yarn, cast on 70 stitches and knit one row (at the end of work this row will be undone); with VIVIENNE col. beige purl 1 row and work in **Tubular** for 4 rows, then continue in **1x1 Rib** for 9 cm (3,54 in.). Continue with needles n. 4 and work in **Stockinette Stitch** with col. green for 4 rows, then in **Garter Stitch** with col. turquoise for 2 rows, in **Stockinette Stitch** with col. beige for 4 rows, and in **Garter Stitch** with col. turquoise for 2 rows. Continue with this alternating color stripe work, increasing 1 stitch at sides every 6 rows 5 times. At a total height of 42 cm (16,53 in.), for the armhole, bind off at sides 3 stitches and continue decreasing 1 stitch every row inside the first 2 stitch. At a total height of 62 cm (24,41 in.), bind off the remaining stitches. Make other sleeve as first one.



Finishing: Sew a shoulder. For the neck, with col. beige pick up the stitches of back and front neckline and work in **1x1 Rib** for 6 rows, then work 4 rows in **Tubular** and bind off in **Tubular** with a needle. Sew the other shoulder, hips, underarms. Apply the sleeve with a pince on the top of armhole.
