

VIENNA



The dress experiments with a set of precious yarns. Silk reigns supreme together with organic virgin wool, which make this garment suitable for a special evening. We wanted it in pink, the romantic color par excellence.



Yarn: BIO MERINO col. 295 pink, VIVIENNE col. 2475 pink.

Needles: n. 4,5

Weight: 500 g/ 17,63 oz. (5 balls Bio Merino, 10 balls Vivienne).

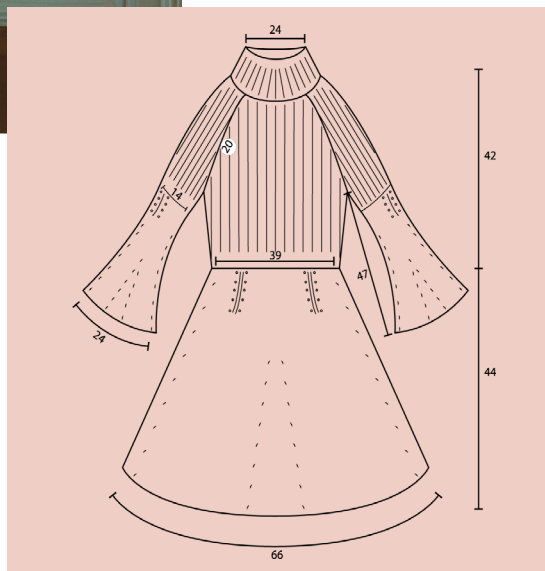
Tg. 42 - S

Stitches Used: Eyelet, Stockinette Stitch, 1x2 Rib, 2x1 Rib, 1x1 Rib, Tubular.

* Yarn Vivienne is worked triple.
Yarn Bio Merino is worked single.

Gauge: 10 cm x 10 cm (4 inc. x 4 inc.): 21 stitches and 28 rows.

Size S: For each bigger or smaller size calculate in width 2 cm (0,75 in.) more or less, in our gauge it corresponds to 4 stitches; calculate in height 2 cm (0,75 in.) more or less, in our gauge it corresponds to 6 rows.

Knitting the Back: With needles n. 4,5 and yarn Vivienne col. pink, cast on 144 stitches and work in **1x1 Rib** for 2 rows. Continue in **Stockinette Stitch**, decreasing at sides 1 stitch every 6 rows, inside the first and last 2 stitches. Make the same at the center's sides, decreasing 1 stitch every 6 rows, inside the first and last 46 stitches. Continue til 33 cm (12,99 in.) in total height, then decrease 1 stitch every 6 rows, only in the center's sides. Simultaneously to the central decreases, make 2 lines of 5 **Eyelet** on the external side of decreases, working 22 stitches per side in **Stockinette Stitch**, then make the **Eyelet**. To make an **Eyelet**, work: yo1, slip1, knit1, pass slipped stitch over. At a total height of 43 cm (16,93 in.), start working in **1x2 Rib** with yarn Bio Merino col. pink, increasing 6 stitches during the execution of the first row. Continue for 22 cm (8,66 in.) with the same number of stitches, then for the raglan, decrease at sides 1 stitch for 20 cm (7,87 in.), inside the first and last 2 stitches. Leave suspended the 36 central stitches for the collar.

Knitting the Front: Work as for the back. At a total height of 78 cm (30,71 in.), for the neckline, bind off the 20 central stitches and continue binding off 2 stitches at sides twice. Then leave suspended the remaining stitches for the collar.

Sleeves: With needles n. 4,5 and yarn Vivienne col. pink, cast on 94 stitches and work in **1x1 Rib** for 2 rows. Continue in **Stockinette Stitch**, decreasing at sides 1 stitch every 6 rows, inside the first and last 2 stitches. Make the same at the center's sides, decreasing 1 stitch every 6 rows, inside the first and last 31 stitches. Continue til 20 cm (7,87 in.) in total height, then decrease 1 stitch every 6 rows, only in the center's sides. Simultaneously to the central decreases, make 2 lines of 5 **Eyelet** on the external side of decreases, working 15 stitches per side in **Stockinette Stitch**, then make the **Eyelet**. To make an **Eyelet**, work: yo1, slip1, knit1, pass slipped stitch over. At a total height of 47 cm, start working in **1x2 Rib** with yarn Bio Merino col. pink, increasing 5 stitches during the execution of the first row. Continue for 11 cm (4,33 in.) with the same number of stitches, then for the raglan, decrease at sides 1 stitch for 20 cm (7,87 in.), inside the first and last 2 stitches. Leave suspended the 10 central stitches per the collar. Make other sleeve as first one.

Finishing: Sew under arms, sides and raglans. For the collar, pick up the stitches left suspended on the back, front and sleeves, and work in **2x1 Rib** for 12 cm (4,72 in.), then make 2 rows in **Tubular**, and bind off in **Tubular** with a needle.
