



Polar Puff



PEARNELOPE

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Intermediate Crochet

MEASUREMENTS

Height (approx) 20cm

PANDSA POLAR PUFF 50g balls

2 balls Leaf (6113)

Small quantity each: Orange (6106) and Latte (6102)

Use only the yarn specified. Other yarns are likely to produce different results. Quantities are approximate as they can vary between crocheters. Ensure all yarn of the same colour is from the same dye lot.

HOOK AND EXTRAS

- 4mm crochet hook.
 - polyester fibre filling.
 - wool needle for finishing.
 - scrap yarn for face embroidery.
- NOTE** – We used Panda Magnum 8 ply (318 Black) and (301 White).

TENSION

NOTE – Australian/UK crochet terminology used throughout.
Correct tension is not essential.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATION

dec = decrease – Insert hook under front lp only of each of next 2 sts, draw yarn through both loops, yoh and draw through 2 lps on hook ... one st dec.

PEAR

Using 4mm hook and Leaf, make 2ch leaving a long end.

NOTE – As rounds are not completed with a sl st but worked in a spiral shape, mark end of rounds with a contrasting thread or marker.

1st round – Miss 1ch, working over long end, 8dc in 2nd ch from hook, do not join with sl st.

NOTE – To reduce centre hole, pull firmly on long end before finishing.

2nd round – 2dc in each dc to end ... 16dc.

3rd round – (1dc in next dc, 2dc in next dc) 8 times ... 24dc.

4th round – (2dc in next dc, 1dc in each of next 3dc) 6 times ... 30dc.

5th round – (1dc in each of next 3dc, 2dc in next dc, 1dc in next dc) 6 times ... 36dc.

6th round – (1dc in each of next 5dc, 2dc in next dc) 6 times ... 42dc.

7th round – (1dc in each of next 2dc, 2dc in next dc, 1dc in each of next 4dc) 6 times ... 48dc.
Work 1 round.

9th round – (1dc in each of next 2dc, 2dc in next dc, 1dc in each of next 3dc) 8 times ... 56dc.
Work 1 round.

11th round – (1dc in each of next 3dc, 2dc in next dc, 1dc in each of next 3dc) 8 times ... 64dc.

Work 2 rounds.

14th round – (**Dec**, 1dc in each of next 6dc) 8 times ... 56dc.

Work 2 rounds.

17th round – (1dc in next dc, **dec**, 1dc in each of next 4dc) 8 times ... 48dc.

Work 2 rounds.

20th round – (1dc in each of next 2dc, **dec**, 1dc in each of next 2dc) 8 times ... 40dc.

Work 2 rounds.

NOTE – Beg inserting fibre filling at this point and top up before fastening off.

23rd round – (1dc in each of next 3dc, **dec**) 8 times ... 32dc.

Work 5 rounds.

29th round – (**Dec**, 1dc in each of next 6dc) 4 times ... 28dc.

Work 1 round.

31st round – (1dc in each of next 2dc, **dec**, 1dc in each of next 3dc) 4 times ... 24dc.

Work 1 round.

33rd round – (**Dec**) 12 times ... 12dc.

34th round – (**Dec**) 6 times ... 6dc.

Fasten off leaving a long end.

STEM

Using 4mm hook and Latte, make 12ch.

1st row – Miss 1ch, sl st in each ch to end.
Fasten off.

LEAF

Using 4mm hook and Orange, make 13 foundation ch.

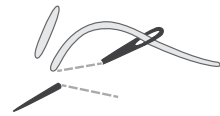
1st row – Miss 1ch, sl st in each of next 4ch, 1dc in next ch, 1htr in next ch, 1tr in next ch, 1dtr in each of next 2ch, 1tr in next ch, 1htr in next ch, 1dc in next ch, 1ch, rotate to work into free lps on other side of foundation ch – 1dc in next ch, 1htr in next ch, 1tr in next ch, 1dtr in each of next 2ch, 1tr in next ch, 1htr in next ch, 1dc in next ch, sl st in next ch. Fasten off.

TO MAKE UP

Using long end at top of Pear, gather stitches to close opening then fasten off securely. Attach Stem and Leaf securely.

Using scraps of black and white yarn and Straight stitches, embroider eyes and mouth.

STRAIGHT STITCH



Work straight stitches. Care must be taken to keep a good shape and length. To prevent puckering, do not pull the stitches too tightly.



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
