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## CATERPILLAR AMIGURUMI 100\% COTTON

## MATERIALS

AMIGURUMI 100\% COTTON S01: 1 bag for the 4 caterpillars 4 craft safety eyes x 6 mm
4 craft safety eyes $\times 4.5 \mathrm{~mm}$
Filling
Crochet hook: C2 (U.S.)/(2.5 mm)

## Stitches

Single crochet, slip st, chain st, magic ring: (see basic instructions in our magazines or www.katia.com)
Increase: make 2 sts in the same st
Decrease: 2 sts closed tog

## INSTRUCTIONS

CATERPILLARS 1 \& 2
HEAD: work in single crochet in a spiral form. To keep a track of how many rows have been worked, place a marker in the first st of each row.
Note: Each Caterpillar is worked the same with the corresponding colour.
Caterpillar 1 = grey, yellow and light green.
Caterpillar 2 = grey, pink and lilac.
Make a magic ring and fill it with 6 single crochet and join these 6 sts with 1 slip st.
Cont increasing in the following manner on the following rows:
$1^{\text {st }}$ row: 1 increase in each st = 12 sts
$\mathbf{2}^{\text {nd }}$ row: * 1 st, 1 increase * rep from * to * $=18$ sts
$3^{\text {rd }}$ row: * 2 sts, 1 increase * rep from * to * $=24$ sts
$4^{\text {th }}$ row: * 3 sts, 1 increase * rep from * to $*=30$ sts
$5^{\text {th }}$ row: * 4 sts, 1 increase * rep from * to * $=36$ sts
$6^{\text {th }}$ row: * 5 sts, 1 increase * rep from * to * $=42$ sts
From the $7^{\text {th }}$ row to the $12^{\text {th }}$ row: work without increasing $=$ 42 sts
Cont decreasing in the following manner:
$13^{\text {th }}$ row: * 5 sts, 1 decrease * rep from * to * $=36$ sts
$14^{\text {th }}$ row: * 4 sts, 1 decrease * rep from * to * $=30$ sts
$15^{\text {th }}$ row: * 3 sts, 1 decrease * rep from * to * = 24 sts
$16{ }^{\text {th }}$ row: * 2 sts, 1 decrease * rep from * to * $=18$ sts
Cut yarn and fasten off.
Place the 6 mm eyes on the $6^{\text {th }}$ row, leaving 8 sts between the eyes.
Fill the head.
Make the mouth: thread a wool sewing needle with yellow yarn for caterpillar 1 and pink for caterpillar 2 and make the desired shape. Make a few eyelashes on caterpillar 2.

BODY: work in single crochet in a spiral form. To keep a track of how many rows have been worked, place a marker in the first st of each row.
Using the corresponding colour make a magic ring and fill it with 6 single crochet and join these 6 sts with 1 slip st.

Cont increasing in the following manner on the following rows:
$1^{\text {st }}$ row: 1 increase in each st = 12 sts
$\mathbf{2}^{\text {nd }}$ row: * 1 st, 1 increase * rep from * to * = 18 sts

3 rd row: * 2 sts, 1 increase * rep from * to * = 24 sts
$4^{\text {th }}$ row: * 3 sts, 1 increase * rep from * to * $=30$ sts
$5^{\text {th }}$ row: * 4 sts, 1 increase * rep from * to * $=36$ sts
From the $6^{\text {th }}$ row to the $11^{\text {th }}$ row: work without increasing $=$ 36 sts
Cont decreasing in the following manner:
$12{ }^{\text {th }}$ row: * 4 sts, 1 decrease * rep from * to * $=30$ sts
$13^{\text {th }}$ row: * 3 sts, 1 decrease * rep from * to * $=24$ sts
$14{ }^{\text {th }}$ row: * 2 sts, 1 decrease * rep from * to * $=18$ sts
Cut yarn and fasten off.
Make a total of 4 pieces the same with 2 in each colour.
Fill each piece and sew one behind another so that the magic ring start of the first and the last piece is at ends.
Sew the head onto the body.

BERET for caterpillar 1: work in single crochet in a spiral form. Using yellow make a magic ring and fill it with 6 single crochet and join these 6 sts with 1 slip st.
Cont increasing in the following manner on the following rows:
$1^{\text {st }}$ row: 1 increase in each st $=12$ sts
$\mathbf{2}^{\text {nd }}$ row: * 1 st , 1 increase * rep from * to * $=18$ sts
$3^{\text {rd }}$ row: * 2 sts, 1 increase * rep from * to * = 24 sts
$4^{\text {th }}$ row: * 3 sts, 1 increase * rep from * to * $=30$ sts
From the $5^{\text {th }}$ row to the $7^{\text {th }}$ row: work without increasing $=30$ sts
Cut yarn and fasten off.
Chain 3 sts and cut the yarn leaving a longish length, fasten off.
Pass the 3 chain sts through the central hole of the beret and sew leaving the 3 sts on the outside. Sew the beret onto one side of the head.

FLOWER for caterpillar 2: work in single crochet in the round. Using pink make a magic ring and fill it with 6 single crochet and join these 6 sts with 1 slip st.
Cont working in the following manner:
$\mathbf{1}^{\text {st }}$ row: * 3 chain sts and 1 slip st * rep from * to * in each single crochet.
$\mathbf{2}^{\text {nd }}$ row: * 1 slip st, 2 single crochet, 1 slip st * rep from * to

* in each arch (= 3 chain sts from the previous row). Cut yarn and fasten off.
Sew the flower onto one side of the head.


## CATERPILLARS 3 \& 4

HEAD: work in single crochet in a spiral form. To keep a track of how many rows have been worked, place a marker in the first st of each row.
Note: each caterpillar is worked the same with the corresponding colour.
Caterpillar 3 = beige, sky blue \& blue.
Caterpillar 4 = beige, white \& pale salmon.
Make a magic ring and fill it with 6 single crochet and join these 6 sts with 1 slip st.
Cont increasing in the following manner on the following rows:
$1^{\text {st }}$ row: 1 increase in each st $=12$ sts
$\mathbf{2}^{\text {nd }}$ row: * 1 st , 1 increase * rep from * to * $=18$ sts
$3^{\text {rd }}$ row: * 2 sts, 1 increase * rep from * to * $=24$ sts
$4^{\text {th }}$ row: * 3 sts, 1 increase * rep from * to * $=30$ sts

From the $5^{\text {th }}$ row to the $\mathbf{1 0}^{\text {th }}$ row: work without increasing $=$ 30 sts
Cont decreasing in the following manner:
11 ${ }^{\text {th }}$ row: * 3 sts, 1 decrease * rep from * to * $=24$ sts
$12^{\text {th }}$ row: * 2 sts, 1 decrease * rep from * to * $=18$ sts
Cut yarn and fasten off.
Place the 4.5 mm eyes on the $4^{\text {th }}$ row, leaving 6 sts between the eyes.
Fill the head.
Make the mouth: thread a wool sewing needle with blue yarn for caterpillar 3 and white for caterpillar 4 and make the desired shape. Make a few eyelashes on caterpillar 4.

BODY: work in single crochet in a spiral form. To keep a track of how many rows have been worked, place a marker in the first st of each row.
Using the corresponding colour make a magic ring and fill it with 6 single crochet and join these 6 sts with 1 slip st.
Cont increasing in the following manner on the following rows:
$1^{\text {st }}$ row: 1 increase in each st = 12 sts
$\mathbf{2}^{\text {nd }}$ row: * 1 st, 1 increase * rep from * to * $=18$ sts
$3^{\text {rd }}$ row: * 2 sts, 1 increase * rep from * to * $=24$ sts
From the $\mathbf{4}^{\text {th }}$ row to the $\mathbf{9}^{\text {th }}$ row: work without increasing $=24$
sts
Cont decreasing in the following manner:
10 th row: * 2 sts, 1 decrease * rep from * to * = 18 sts
Cut yarn and fasten off.
Make a total of 4 pieces the same with 2 in each colour.
Fill each piece and sew one behind another so that the magic ring start of the first and the last piece is at ends.
Sew the head onto the body.
BERET for caterpillar 3: work in single crochet in a spiral form. Using blue make a magic ring and fill it with 6 single crochet and join these 6 sts with 1 slip st.
Cont increasing in the following manner on the following rows:
$1^{\text {st }}$ row: 1 increase in each st = 12 sts
$\mathbf{2}^{\text {nd }}$ row: * 1 st, 1 increase * rep from * to * $=18$ sts
$3^{\text {rd }}$ row: * 2 sts, 1 increase * rep from * to * $=24$ sts
From the $\mathbf{4}^{\text {th }}$ row to the $\mathbf{6}^{\text {th }}$ row: work without increasing $=24$
sts
Cut yarn and fasten off.
Chain 3 sts and cut the yarn leaving a longish length, fasten off.
Pass the 3 chain st through the central hole of the beret and sew leaving the 3 sts on the outside. Sew the beret onto one side of the head.

FLOWER for caterpillar 4: work in single crochet in the round. Using white make a magic ring and fill it with 6 single crochet and join these 6 sts with 1 slip st.
Cont working in the following manner:
$\mathbf{1}^{\text {st }}$ row: * 3 chain sts, 1 slip st * rep from * to * in each single crochet.
$\mathbf{2}^{\text {nd }}$ row: * 1 slip st, 2 single crochet, 1 slip st * rep from * to * in each arch ( $=3$ chain sts from the previous row). Cut yarn and fasten off.
Sew the flower onto one side of the head.
