<u>Crochet Bookmark</u>

Materials

1 Katia Amigurumi 100% Cotton assortment (S05): mustard, red, flesh, olive green, ivory, blue and brick. 1 Katia Amigurumi 100% Cotton assortment (S02): yellow, black, green and brown. Orochet hook size C2 (U.S.)/(2.5 mm) Wool sewing needle



Measurements

7 1/2" (19 cm) long and 3/4" (2 cm) wide (at body) / 1 5/8" (4 cm) (at head), approximately

Stitches and abbreviations

- $\boldsymbol{X} = \text{Single crochet}$
- ●= Slip stitch
- $\mathbf{V} =$ Increase: make 2 stitches from 1 stitch
- Λ = Decrease: make 1 stitch from 2 consecutive stitches
- **0** = Chain stitch
- \mathbf{F} = Double crochet
- \mathbf{T} = Half double crochet
- $\left[\ \right] =$ The stitches in brackets are made in the same stitch
- ()* = Repeat the indicated in parentheses

VUTSRQPONNEKJERGER M made with ; 30 : Kalting

<u>Colour A</u>: black (Snow White & Harry Potter), brick (Peter Pan), mustard (Little Prince) and brown (Little Red Riding Hood)


Row	Stitches to be worked	Total sts
Start	(Colour A) Magic ring 6 X	6
1	V in each stitch	12
2	(X + V)* 6 times	18
3	(2 X + V)* 6 times	24
4-8	(Colour B) X in each stitch	24
9	(2 X + ∧)* 6 times	18
10	(X + A)* 6 times	12

11	6 A	6





Body (all)

Make the body of each character in crochet following the graph:



Row	Stitches to be worked	Total sts
Start	4 0	4
1	X in each stitch 0 + turn work	3
2	V + X + V 0 + turn work	5
3-41	X in each stitch 0 + turn work	5
42	X in each stitch	5

Cut the yam, fasten off the loose ends and carefully block (press) before sewing.

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<u>Crochet Bookmark</u>

Little Prince's bow tie / Snow White's bow

Row	Stitches to be worked	Total sts
Start	(Red) 6 0	6
1-2	X in each stitch 0 + turn work	5
3	X in each stitch	5

Cut the yarn leaving a length to wrap around the centre a few times to form the bow/bow tie.

Snow White's hair

Row	Stitches to be worked	Total sts
Start	(Black) 17 0	17
1-4	X in each stitch 0 + turn work	16
5	$(\mathbf{\Phi} + [\mathbf{T} + \mathbf{F}] + [\mathbf{F} + \mathbf{T}])^* 5$ times $\mathbf{\Phi}$ in the last stitch	26

Cut the yarn leaving a longish length to sew with later.

Snow White's fringe

Row	Stitches to be worked	Total sts
Start	(Black) 11 0	11
1	(● + T + [Ŧ + Ŧ] + T + ●)* 2 times	12

Cut the yarn leaving a longish length to sew with later.

Collar of Snow White's dress

Row	Stitches to be worked	Total sts
Start	(Ivory) 15 0	15
1		16

Cut the yarn leaving a longish length to sew with later.

Harry Potter's scarf

Make the colour changes following the pattern. Displace the yarn of the colour not being worked inside the stitches:

Row	Stitches to be worked	Total sts
Start	(Red) 57 0	57
1	X in each stitch 0 + turn work	56
2	X in each stitch	56

Cut the yarn and fasten off the loose ends.

Snow White's hair band

Row	Stitches to be worked	Total sts
Start	(Red) 10 0	10

Cut the yarn leaving a longish length to sew with later.

Little Red Riding Hood's hood

Row	Stitches to be worked	Total sts
Start	(Red) Magic ring 6 X	6
1	V in each stitch	12
2	(X + V)* 6 times	18
3	(2 X + V)* 6 times	24
4	(3 X + V)* 6 times	30
5-9	X in each stitch ● to join in row 9	30

Cut the yarn leaving a longish length to sew with later.

Little Red Riding Hood's cape

Row	Stitches to be worked	Total sts
Start	(Red) 13 0	13
1-2	X in each stitch 0 + turn work	12
3	X in each stitch	12

Cut the yarn leaving a longish length to sew with later.

Peter Pan's hat feather


Row	Stitches to be worked	Total sts
Start	(Red) 5 0	5
1	X in each stitch	4

Cut the yarn leaving a longish length to sew with later.

Peter Pan's hat

Row	Stitches to be worked	Total sts
Start	(Green) Magic ring 4 X	4
1	$(\mathbf{X} + \mathbf{V})^*$ 2 times	6
2	(2 X + V)* 2 times	8
3	(3 X + V)* 2 times	10
4	(4 X + V)* 2 times	12
5	(5 X + V)* 2 times	14
6	5 X +4 V +5 X ● to join	18

Cut the yarn leaving a longish length to sew with later.



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Making up

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Join the parts together as shown for each character:

Details All

Nose: using flesh work various stitches in the middle of the head. (photo)

Eves: using black work two small stitches at each side of the nose. (photo)

Blusher: paint on with a pink marker pen. (photo)

Little Prince

Hairstyle: using mustard work loose stitches to create loops all over the head. (photo)

Snow White

Lips: embroider in red. (photo) Hairstyle: sew the hair and the fringe onto the head along the row of the colour change. Band with bow: sew the band onto the head and add the bow at one side. (photo)

Harry Potter

Scar: using the brick colour, make a few tiny stitches in the form of a lightning strike on one side of the forehead.

Hairstyle: cut 2" (5 cm) lengths of black yarn. Attach them onto the head stitches with the help of a crochet hook. Trim the yarn so the hair is even. (photo) Glasses: make two circles at the end of a fine piece of black wire and fold slightly in the middle. Attach to the face with 3 stitches.

Little Red Riding Hood

Fringe: using brown work a few long diagonal stitches

from one side of the head towards the other side of the

Hairstyle: cut 3 78" (10 cm) lengths of brown yarn. Group them together to make two sections of hair and fold in half. Sew each section in the middle at each side of the head. Wrap and tie some brown yarn around them to make the pigtails.

Hood: attach to the head leaving the pigtails of hair on the outside.

Peter Pan

Hairstyle: using brick work long stitches from the stitches at the centre of the head outwards to create the peaks.
